

**Park County Board of County Commissioners  
Regular Meeting  
May 12, 2015**

Chairman Tilden called to order a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Park County, Wyoming, on Tuesday, May 12, 2015. Present were Chairman Joe Tilden, Vice Chairman Lee Livingston, Commissioners Loren Grosskopf, Bucky Hall, Tim French, and Teecee Barrett Deputy County Clerk.

Commissioner Hall led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Approve-Health & Wellness Committee Funding Recommendations for Health Insurance.**

Eric Deeg, Health Insurance Consultant, joined by conference call to discuss the recommendation of the Health & Wellness Committee for fiscal year 2015-2016 funding rates. It was the recommendation of the Committee to raise funding 17.8% on all tier of funding. After general discussion it was moved by Commissioner Hall to approve the funding rate increase of 17.8%, seconded by Commissioner Grosskopf and unanimously carried.

**Recess for Lunch.**

**Update-Ray & Jackie Maple a.k.a Tom O'Day and Bronco Nell.**

Ray and Jackie Maple updated the Board on the past year of his activities promoting the historical history of Tom O'Day. He has done several shows on the Eastern end of the state with a great turnout as well as being invited back for other shows in the future. Next Month he will be visiting the actual grave site of Tom and there will be a ceremony to place a tomb stone as it is currently an unmarked grave. He also thanked the Board of Commissioners for all of their support and offered them a private show if they wish.

**Update-Fairgrounds Building.**

Ron Yount, Project Architect, updated the Board on the progress of the new building. The structure is 75% complete at the moment with siding going up as well as the mechanical being installed. Synergy Construction has committed to a completion date of July 11<sup>th</sup>. He showed the Board a proposed site for setting the donor pavers and brought samples of potential paving blocks. After general discussion it was the consensus of the Board to put some sort of decorative rock in the area where the pavers are until there is more information of the total cost of the blocks. The Board also chose interior carpet and counter colors.

**Approval-of Minutes: Regular Meeting May 5th and; Special Meeting May 8th.**

Commissioner Hall made a motion to approve the minutes of May 5, 2015 and May 8, 2015 as submitted, seconded by Commissioner Livingston and unanimously carried.

**Approve-Sign Agreement for Health Care Services in Park County.**

Sheriff Department Lieutenant Tod Larson presented the amended agreement for the Health Care Services Contract for inmate care. The only change was the annual increase for health care inflation. After general discussion it was moved by Commissioner Hall to approve the contract and allow the Chairman to sign, seconded by Commissioner Grosskopf and unanimously carried.

**Clarification- 24-Hour Requests for Liquor Establishments.**

Hans Odde, 1<sup>st</sup> Deputy Clerk, wanted to inform the Board that by approving one establishments request to be open for 24-hours, this is allowing all County liquor license holders to be open the same hours as the establishment with the request.

**Approve-Pay Scale for Fairgrounds Employees.**

Echo Renner, County Events Coordinator, came before the Board to ask for approval of Fair Employee wages. After general discussion it was moved by Commissioner Hall to set the pay scale for \$7.50 to \$14.00 per hour subject to budget constraints, seconded by Commissioner Livingston and unanimously carried.

**Discussion- Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Budget.**

Per Wyoming State Statute 16-4-102 (vi) the preliminary budget was presented to the Board, with some direction given to the County Clerk's office on going forward for the next budget discussion.

**Adjournment**

Commissioner Hall made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner French and the motion carried.
