Park County Board of County Commissioners Regular Meeting March 8, 2016

Chairman French called to order a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Park County, Wyoming, on Tuesday, March 8, 2016. Present were Chairman Tim French, Vice Chairman Lee Livingston, Commissioners Loren Grosskopf, Bucky Hall, Joe Tilden, and Deputy Clerk Teecee Barrett.

Commissioner Hall led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman French asked for a motion to amend the proposed agenda as County Clerk Colleen Renner requested to address the Board in regards to hiring a employee. Commission Tilden made a motion to amend the agenda, adding Colleen Renner after the County Attorney. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Livingston and unanimously carried.

Request-Hiring Deputy County Attorney and Legal Secretary.

Bryan Skoric, County Attorney, requested approval to replace a Deputy County Attorney and a Legal Secretary. Skoric said both positions are vital to the function of his office. He plans to hire both positions at a lower step and pay grade to be fiscally responsible. Commissioner Hall made motion to allow the hiring of both the Deputy County Attorney and Legal Secretary positions, with the motion seconded by Commissioner Livingston and unanimously carried

Approval-Hiring Payroll Clerk Position.

Colleen Renner, County Clerk, informed the Board that the Payroll Clerk had resigned. The position is vital to the county. The Board asked if the replacement will be hired at the same wage. Renner will present a proposed pay range to the Board for approval on March 15. It was the consensus of the Board to allow Renner to advertise for the position, with hiring pending the Board's approval of the pay.

Discussion-Continue Discussion of Consensus Funds.

County Clerk Colleen Renner discussed with the Board the capital projects that are eligible for funding by Consensus monies. Proposed projected included the Cody Road and Bridge shop expansion, employee parking lot paving, the ArcaSearch project for documents in the County Clerk vault, bird netting at the fairgrounds, and Andy Martin Hill. The Board asked Renner to work with the departments and present a resolution to include actual numbers and completion dates at the March 15 meeting.
