Budget Discussion

Park County received the Federal Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILT) in the amount of \$1,838,794, which will leave the county with approximately \$455,000 remaining for this fiscal year. Commissioner Grosskopf made a motion to adjust PILT in the fiscal year 17-18 budget to what was received, Commissioner Fulkerson seconded, Commissioner French opposed, and motion carried.

Some departments have requested raises for employees whose duties have increased, changed, or for merit. Chairman Livingston stated these will be addressed in executive session with the departments at the next regular meeting, July 5. Park County Library and Museum will receive the same amount that is designated to departments if an across the board raise or bonus is given to all county employees.

Mr. Brian Edwards, County Engineer, reported there is a chance the county will get money through Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), with a disaster declaration, for damage caused by flooding on the Southfork. County Road Funds could be used for these repairs if monies are not received from FEMA. Commissioner Tilden stated he would like to not add funds to the 17-18 budget at this time and instead wait to see what the actual costs will be and what is received from FEMA.

Hire replacement employee- Sheriff's Administrative Assistant

Chairman Livingston stated this is a key position and wants Mr. Steward to be able to move forward with an approval today. Commissioner Fulkerson made a motion for this position to be filled with the wage not to exceed the current salary, Commissioner Grosskopf seconded, and motion carried.

Adjourn.
