### <u>Commissioners – RE: Land Use Plan Update with Clarion Associates</u>

Ms. White stated the group is conducting community meetings this week, with a virtual option October 12 and an online survey available through the end of October.

Ms. White stated a draft plan will be available December 6 for internal use with a third round of public outreach from January 30-February 2. Ms. White reminded the board that the land use plan is an advisory document with regulations to follow. There will be public comment periods and notification requirements before the processes are complete.

# <u>Ben McDonald, Public Works Department – RE: Open Bids for Used Bridge Girders</u>

There were two bids received for eight available girders.

Alan Grabber bid \$750 for two girders or \$3,000 for four girders. Nicholson Dirt Contracting bid \$1,300 per section, offering \$10,400 for all eight girders.

Mr. McDonald will run all scenarios and return with recommendations.

A discussion was held on the county's potential use of the girders, the cost of moving them and the timeline for removal from county property.

### Commissioners - RE: Review Lease Agreement for Northwest College

Chairwoman Overfield stated the agreement is for the use of the commercial kitchen at Heart Mountain Hall at the fairgrounds. A discussion followed on the base rental rate. The college will use the facility January 1, 2023 – July 2, 2024.

Commissioner Thiel moved to approve the lease agreement as written with \$1,000 per month to cover utilities, zero security deposit and to allow the chair to sign. Commissioner Mangold seconded.

NWC President Lisa Watson said she wanted the college's lawyers to look over the agreement. Commissioner Thiel noted the document is not final until all parties sign it. Motion carried.

#### Ben McDonald, Public Works Department - returned with recommendations

Mr. McDonald reported he talked to both bidders: Nicholson will remove the girders by October/November while Mr. Grabber will not be able to do so until June 2023. The recommendation is to take Nicholson's bid for all 8 sections at \$1,300 apiece.

Commissioner Tilden moved to accept the recommendation, Commissioner Livingston seconded. It was noted that the girders aren't needed by the county and Nicholson plans to use them on a private road. Motion carried.
