Brian Edwards, Engineer, and Travis Ball, Solid Waste Manager – RE: Open and Review Sealed Bids for Scrap Metal Recycling at the Park County Landfills

Mr. Edwards stated two bids were received for scrap metal from Harris Trucking dba Wyoming Steel Service and Western Metal Recycling, Utah. Harris bid was \$161.50 per ton and Western Metal bid \$165.49 per ton. Discussions on 5% out of state eligibility, two years ago the bid was \$140.00 per ton, need to review agreement which is specific for time fame of metal removal to be done.

Commissioner Thiel made a motion to award the scrap metal bid to Harris Trucking, Commissioner Livingston seconded and allow chair to sign once the requirements of the agreement have been met. Motion carried.

Commissioners – RE: Park County Commissioner Scholarship Selection

Commissioner Livingston tallied the score sheets, there are three scholarships available for \$500 per semester. There were twelve applicants and renewals will be reviewed during the April 18 meeting.

Commissioner Livingston read the tallied scores and names in order of rank, after discussions regarding a student from each community receiving a scholarship Commissioner Mangold made a motion to award a scholarship to the highest score in each community, Commissioner Thiel seconded, motion carried. The scholarships will go to Remy Broussard, Jayci Ervin and Lyla Never with Gabriella Paterson being the alternate.

Commissioners – RE: Portion of ARPA Funds for NACo

Commissioner Thiel presented the background of the \$12 million which the National Association of Counties worked to procure for the counties rather than the state. Congress supports public land counties and with funding just received NACo and WIR voted to proceed with developing a National Center of Public Lands Counties (the Center).

Commissioner Thiel moved to approve \$120,000 as a place holder on the GENERAL ARPA fund spreadsheet, Commissioner Livingston seconded for discussion and asked if this was a request at this time. Not a request at this time and not a guarantee that we will give them the money until we learn more at the WCCA meeting in May, motion carried.

<u>Commissioners – RE: Review and Allow Chair to Sign Updated Law</u> <u>Enforcement Center Agreement</u>

Chairwoman Overfield stated that the County and City of Cody have been working on this agreement for two years which cover the joint occupancy of the law enforcement center and its operations and expenses. The two attorneys have reviewed the document and the city approved the agreement at the council meeting last week.

Commissioner Livingston thanked all those involved and made a motion to approve the agreement and allow the chair to sign, Commissioner Thiel seconded, motion carried.

Executive Session.

Commissioner Livingston made a motion to enter executive session pursuant to W.S. § 16-4-405(a)(ix), Commissioner Mangold seconded, and motion carried.

Commissioner Thiel moved to exit from executive session, Commissioner Mangold seconded, and the motion carried. No decisions were made in or as a result of the executive session.

Karen Horner, Library Director, Park County Library – RE: Request Permission to Serve Alcohol for Fundraiser in Library

Karen Horner introduced Barb Quick, secretary of the Library Foundation Board who is hosting a fundraiser for all Park County Libraries, Saturday, August 19 with themes, appetizers and would like approval for a mobile bar tending service to be present in the library. Commissioner Livingston questioned whether this is allowable in a public building and requested that the county attorney review the proposal. Commissioner Mangold made a motion to approve pending County Attorney approval of alcohol to be served in the county building, Commissioner Thiel seconded, motion carried.
