




WHERE DID YOU MOVE TO PARK COUNTY FROM?





Includes food trucks and downtown events


• Improved services Roads, Emergency, Schools, Library What not-so-positive changes have you noticed in Park County since you've been back?

 - Resistance to Change Includes concerns of "protectionism" and lost opportunities for economic growth
- Decreased Access to Nature Includes wildlife, recreation and open spaces.


• Changing culture and values


How would you rate the following economic indicators in Park County?




New development (in the last 5-10 years) in my planning area...




New development (in the last 5-10 years) in my planning area is...

Keep small town feeling where families still mean something, and quality of life comes first.


Country living! I would also like to see a more diverse shopping experience close by instead of having to travel to Billings to buy things because there is much better selection of everything!
